



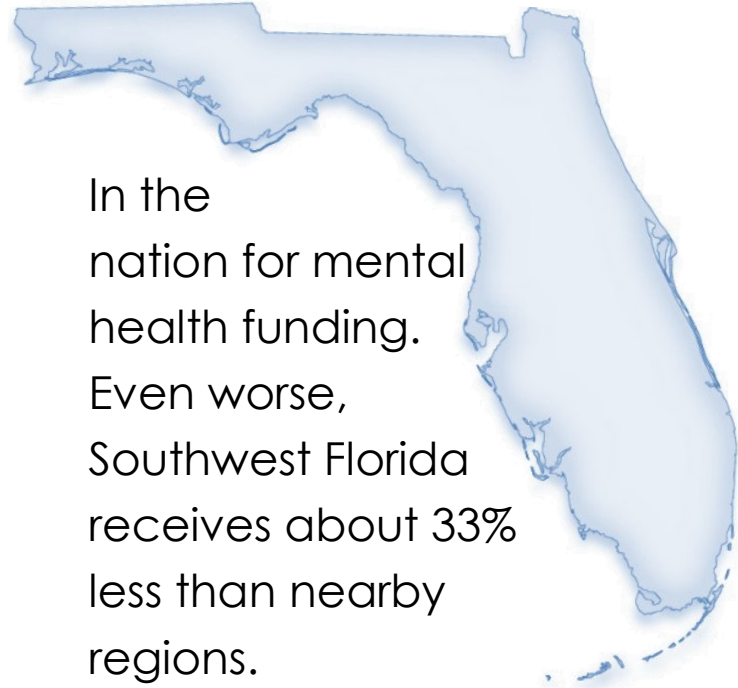

Know the Facts

- Suicide is the **10th leading cause** of death in the United States. 90% of those that have passed lived with a mental illness.
- Although those living with mental illness are often perceived as being violent individuals, they are actually over **10 times more likely** to be victims of violent crime than the general population.
- **79% of children** living with mental health disorders do not receive treatment.
- The average delay between the onset of mental health symptoms and seeking help is **8-10 years**.
- Serious mental illness costs America **\$193.2 billion** in lost earnings every year.
- Schizophrenia is **6 times more common** than diabetes.

In the nation for mental health funding. Even worse, Southwest Florida receives about 33% less than nearby regions.








Know the Signs

Some common signs of varying mental illnesses include:

- Feeling sad or down
- Extreme mood changes of highs and lows
- Alcohol or drug abuse
- Excessive anger, hostility, or violence
- Delusions, paranoia, or hallucinations
- Suicidal thinking
